



New Commonwealth Mandate for Broadband

What is the New Broadband Law?

The General Assembly of Virginia has amended Section 15.2-2223 and 15.2-2224 of the Code of Virginia to establish requirements for each locality in the Commonwealth to prepare a comprehensive plan with strategies for broadband infrastructure. The law states that in preparation of these plans, local planning commissions should conduct surveys and studies of existing conditions and growth trends, plus probable future broadband requirements of its territory. These plans should be in alignment with current developmental needs and anticipated future needs and resources that will also "...promote the health, safety, morals, order, convenience, prosperity and general welfare of inhabitants...."
